Featured Fund: The Golden Log Truckers

The Golden Log Truckers Association (GTA) has done it again. These hardworking residents have made another gift to their fund held within the Community Foundation.

At the same time, they gave another gift to the Palliative Care Fund, started by Chris and Susie Schaap in memory of Gordon Boettger, a long time Golden resident and Log Truck owner-operator.

The Palliative Care Fund has now reached the \$10,000 threshold for granting, and the GTA Fund has a balance of over \$82,000, supporting Community needs.

The Golden Log Truckers have a unique agreement with Louisiana Pacific, a holdover from the days of Evans Forest Products. Fines collected for hauling overweight loads are returned to the Truckers Association for charitable donation. In 2005, the Log Truckers decided to create a Fund within the Community Foundation to hold their donations in perpetuity - For our Future.

Through their Fund, the Golden Log Truckers have supported many organizations - Golden Search and Rescue, Golden Food Bank, Golden Women's Centre, Golden Community Resources Society and Little Mittens, to name but a few. They have touched so many of us.

These men and women truly understand what it means to be a part of a community and their generosity is an example to us all.
