In March, 41 project proposals were received requesting over \$1 million in funding from Columbia Basin Trust's Community Initiatives and Affected Areas Programs. After Public Input Session presentations in April and careful review by the Community Funds Local Selection Committee, 15 projects were awarded a total of \$346,923.29, the full amount available.
